THE COMMUNITY



Home to approximately 8,700 residents, Milton, Washington is a picturesque city nestled between Tacoma and Seattle, offering a perfect blend of small-town charm and big-city convenience. Those who

Milton is known for its close-knit environment, lush landscapes, and temperate climate. Through strong leadership, frequent community events, quality schools, and strong relationships between citizens, businesses and the city government, Milton has retained its picturesque charm and quality.

The city's numerous parks and recreational areas include the Hill Tower Park, West Milton Nature Preserve, Milton Community Park, West Milton Park, Milton Commons Skatepark, and the Milton Interurban Trail encourage residents to engage in a healthy, active lifestyle. THE CITY

The City of Milton was incorporated in 1907 and operates under a mayor-council form of government consisting of a seven-member City Council, each serving four-year terms. The City employs 50 FTEs and operated on a 2023 budget of \$28,616,299. The City provides a range of municipal services including law enforcement, planning and community development, street maintenance and improvements, parks and recreation, and general administrative services, and owns and operates water, electric, and stormwater utility systems.

THE DEPARTMENT

The Public Works Department consists of three divisions. The Planning and Building division (3 FTEs) operated with a 2023 budget of \$858,676. The Electric division (3 FTEs) operated with a 2023 budget of \$5,420,506 for operations and \$2,662,205 for capital. The Facilities, Parks, Streets, Water, Stormwater, and Fleet Maintenance Division (14 FTEs) operated with a 2023 budget of \$5,477,357 for operations (excluding transfers) and \$8,674,290 for capital.

THE POSITION

Reporting to the Public Works Director, the City Engineer provides quality customer service both internally and externally and manages design and construction of the City's capital projects. This position performs advanced civil engineering work in the planning, design, and construction of municipal public works facilities and infrastructure, which includes streets, signals, storm water, parks and municipal buildings. The City Engineer manages, coordinates and reviews development projects for consistency with City codes and standards, oversees both private and City infrastructure construction, and performs inspection to assure City development standards are followed. The City Engineer may act as a liaison to other public agencies, engineering consultants, public utilities, and developers, and acts as Public Works Director in their absence.
