WHY APPLY?



Located on the scenic shores of Oakland Bay, the City of Shelton is known for its outdoor recreational opportunities. Residents enjoy the benefits of small-town life with all the urban amenities of Olym-

pia just twenty minutes away. The City of Shelton is undertaking major expansions of its water and sewer systems, planning a multiuse pathway through the downtown along Goldsborough Creek, reviewing proposed subdivisions for thousands of new homes, and preparing for an update to the City Comprehensive Plan this year. The City is also attracting new and exciting businesses, prompting a demand for additional infrastructure. If you are an experienced professional looking for a challenging and rewarding career opportunity across the spectrum of civil engineering disciplines, this is the right position for you!

THE COMMUNITY

Located in Mason County, Washington, Shelton is the county seat and occupies an area of 6.1 square miles. With nearly 12,000 residents, the City is the main population center and service provider for the region. Logging and lumber milling have long been the economic foundation for Shelton, but the economy is expanding in other areas, as well.

Shelton is in close proximity to Hood Canal, the only true saltwater fjord in the lower United States. Its clear deep waters provide world-class shrimp and salmon fishing, scuba diving, and miles of pristine shoreline for boaters, kayakers, and beachcombers. Immediately west of Shelton is Olympic National Park and Olympic National Forest. Here you will find mountain trails, thrilling vistas, temperate rainforests, waterfalls and more. Lake Cushman, the Mt. Ellinor Trail and the Staircase entrance to Olympic National Park are just three of the top attractions.

The Shelton School District is composed of seven schools: three elementary, one middle school for sixth and seventh grades, one junior high for eighth and ninth grades, one high school, and one CHOICE alternative school. Olympic College, a two-year community/technical college, has a campus in the northeast part of town.

THE CITY

The City of Shelton operates under the Council-Manager form of government. The Shelton City Council consists of seven individuals who are responsible for policymaking for the City. Each councilmember is elected to serve a four-year term. Councilmembers are elected citywide.

Shelton is a full-service city that provides a wide range of municipal services, including City Administration, City Clerk, Community and Economic Development, Finance, Human Resources, Information Technology, Municipal Court, Police, Public Works, and Parks & Recreation. Fire service is provided by Central Mason Fire & Rescue. The City has 99.53 FTEs, and operates with a total budget of \$44 million, including a general fund of \$15.5 million.




THE DEPARTMENT

The mission of the Public Works department is to enhance the safety, welfare, and livability of our community by providing and managing reliable infrastructure and services for transportation, water, stormwater, and wastewater systems. The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance and improvement of the City's infrastructure, including streets, sidewalks, water service, wastewater treatment, storm drainage, and fleet/equipment. These systems that serve the public focus on transportation and mobility, water treatment/delivery, stormwater quality/quantity, and wastewater collection/disposal. Public Works operates with 39 FTEs and a 2024 operating budget of \$17.5 million.

THE POSITION

Working under the general supervision of the Public Works Director, the Assistant Public Works Director/City Engineer supervises the Senior Inspector, Engineer Technician, and GIS Technician, and other employees as assigned. This position is responsible for City engineering services related to the review of design and construction plans submitted to the City, including areas related to water service, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, road and street systems, and traffic control, and is responsible for the design of construction projects in those same areas. This position coordinates assigned activities with other departments and outside agencies and provides highly responsible and complex administrative support to the Public Works Director.





Essential Duties & Responsibilities include:

- Provide engineering assistance and advice on all matters pertaining to streets, traffic, drainage, sewer, and water utilities.
- Provide oversight and direction for permitting, private development review, and construction inspection activities within Public Works.
- Assure new projects comply with the Engineering Design and Construction Standards, & Municipal Code.
- Lead the Engineering Group to ensure standards are met for productivity, efficiency, and for both internal and external customer satisfaction.
- Select, train, motivate, and evaluate project Engineering Division personnel.
- Develop and budget yearly for six-year water, wastewater, storm drainage, and transportation improvement capital projects to ensure effective expansion and operation of infrastructure.
- Assist the City Capital Projects Manager and Public Works Director in the design and construction of City infrastructure projects that are funded by the City, State, or Federal programs.
